## Dissolution of Marriage

Tentative Draft No. 1 October 21, 1968

- Section 1. Marriage is dissolved only by (1) the death of one of a Court of the (\_\_\_\_\_\_) court to decreeing a dissolution of the marriage.
- Section 2. A judgment decreeing the dissolution of a marriage shall be granted only upon proof that the marriage has irretrievably broken down, and upon no other ground.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The effect of a judgment decreeing the dissolution of a marriage is to restore the parties to the status of unmarried persons.
- Section 4. A proceeding for the dissolution of a marriage shall be correspond by the filing of a petition, called a petition of inquiry, with the clerk of the court, requesting the court to inquire into the continuance of the marriage.
